Illness/Misadventure Appeal for Assessments, including Examinations

Students who are ill, have an accident or misadventure immediately prior to or during the course of an Assessment have the right to appeal on the grounds of:

- i) failing to complete an Assessment
- ii) failing to attend an Assessment
- iii) feeling they have been unable to do justice to themselves in an Assessment Task.

When to Appeal

- i) if you require an extension due to illness your **Subject Teacher** must be informed immediately and form submitted
- ii) if illness, accident or misadventure prevents your attendance at an Assessment, your **Subject Teacher** must be informed immediately and form submitted.

How to Appeal

Submit full details of the Appeal on SECTION A of the Illness / Misadventure form, supported by Medical and / or other appropriate evidence to the subject Teacher.
